

#### Language, Literacy and Numeracy Requirement for VET Courses

- 1. LLN test is a MANDATORY requirement for EVERY VET STUDENTS who is enrolling for a Vocational Qualification at Melbourne Metropolitan College.
- 2. The LLN test will be used for determining a student's Language, Literacy and Numeracy skills.
- 3. If the student misses any part/skills assessment, then he/she will be asked to undertake this again.
- 4. If the student is enrolling for a packaged program, then the first AQF level qualification LLN Test should be administered to the student.
- 5. The LLN Test can be taken prior to the Orientation Day or will have to be taken on Orientation Day.

#### **English language requirements**

To enroll into this course with MMC, international students, applying either off-shore or on-shore, must satisfy one of the following requirements:

I.Either a minimum IELTS test score of 5.5 or equivalent for direct entry into a VET course;

or, IELTS score of 5.0 or equivalent with an ELICOS course (up to 10 weeks) to be taken before the main VET course.

or, IELTS score of 4.5 or equivalent with an ELICOS course (up to 20 weeks) to be taken before the main VET course.

Results more than two years old are not acceptable.

II. Evidence that they have studied in English for at least five years in Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Republic of Ireland, South Africa, United Kingdom or United States.

III. Evidence that, within two years of their application date, they have successfully completed in Australia a foundation course or a senior secondary certificate of education or a substantial part of a Certificate IV or higher level qualification, from the Australian Qualifications Framework.

OR

- For students from Assessment Levels 1 and 2 only, successful completion of MMC's Language and Numeracy Test conducted on MMC's campus (for onshore international students ONLY.)
- In certain countries, prospective students may be exempt from the IELTS test requirement, as ٧. successful completion of our Language, Literacy, and Numeracy (LLN) test alone is deemed sufficient to qualify for an offer letter.

- 1. The applicant is required to complete the following:
  - Sign the MMC/Langford Enrolment Form
  - Attach all the relevant certificate academic transcripts in line with the Entry Requirements
  - Provide Proof of English proficiency of an IELTS score of 5.5 or equivalent
  - Documents in a language other than English must be translated by a NAATI approved translator only
  - Sign the student Acceptance Agreement and make the initial tuition fee deposit as indicated in the Student Acceptance Agreement
  - Take the MMC LLN test prior to the course commencement on the day of the Orientation
- 2. Successful applicants would receive a full or conditional Letter of Offer and a Student Acceptance Agreement.
- If the applicant is claiming Credit Transfer Original Statement of Attainment or Original Qualification certificate has to be cited and verified by the Admissions officer.
- While issuing a CoE, if the PRISMS prompts for complying with Standard 7 of NCP 2018 regarding transfer of students, the student should be able to advise on that.
- 5. The student will be required to apply for a Unique Student Identifier (USI) if he/she does not have one.
